1 Online Through Social Security

If you prefer speaking with someone directly, you can call Social Security at **1-800-772-1213**. They're available Monday through Friday, from 8 AM to 7 PM.

3 Visit a Local SSA Office

If you like the idea of face-to-face assistance, you can visit your local Social Security office. Use the online office locator tool at **SSA.GOV** to find the nearest one.



More Ways to Update Your Address

1 Medicare's Online Portal

You can also update your address directly through Medicare's website at **MEDICARE.GOV**. Log in to your account and look for the section where you can update personal information. Have your Medicare card handy for reference.

2 Call Medicare Directly

If you're more comfortable on the phone, calling Medicare at **1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227)** is another option. Representatives are available **24/7** to assist you.

 No matter which method you choose, make sure to act promptly after you've moved to avoid missing out on critical information.



All 5 Ways to Update Your Medicare Address

Here's a quick reference summary of every method available to you:

Online – Social Security	SSA.GOV – log in and update address	24/7
Call Social Security	1-800-772-1213	Mon–Fri, 8 AM–7 PM
Visit Local SSA Office	Find location at SSA.GOV	Business hours
Medicare Online Portal	MEDICARE.GOV – log in and update info	24/7
Call Medicare Directly	1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227)	24/7



Processing Time for Address Changes

Once you've submitted your address change, the processing time can vary depending on how you choose to update it:

Online Updates

1-2

Days to Process

Typically processed within 1-2 days.

Phone or In-Person Updates

5-10

Business Days

May take 5-10 business days due to manual processing requirements.

- ❑ After about **two weeks** following your update, it's a good idea to check back and ensure that your new address is reflected in the system. You can either log into your online account or call Medicare for verification.

Do You Need to Notify Your Private Insurance Provider?

If you're enrolled in a **Medicare Advantage or Supplement plan**, it's important to notify your private insurance company about your new address as well. These plans operate separately from traditional Medicare and maintain their own records.

Traditional Medicare

Update via SSA.GOV, Medicare.gov, or by phone. Records are managed by the federal government.

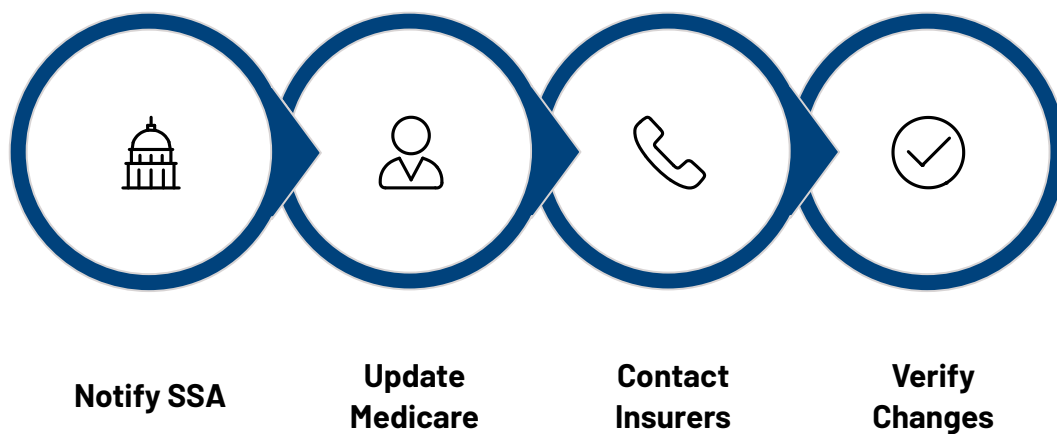
Medicare Advantage / Supplement

These plans operate **separately** from traditional Medicare and maintain their own records. You must notify them independently.

- ❑ Failing to inform your private insurance provider could result in missing out on critical information related to your coverage. Therefore, you must keep **both Medicare and any private insurance providers** updated on your address change.

Step-by-Step: What to Do When You Move

Follow this simple process to make sure all your Medicare information stays current after a move:



Taking these steps in order ensures that both your federal Medicare records and any private plan records are fully updated, preventing gaps in coverage or missed communications.
